B&T Club:

Late collections - we are noticing an unacceptable increase in late collections.

A reminder that each late collection will incur a fine of **£10 per child per occasion** (historically set by Governors). So far this term we have not applied the fine, but from Monday 16th May we will be applying this. If you are running late please let us know - you can leave a message, B&T staff will check the answer phone if children are still here. Staff have other commitments / need to collect their own children - it is not fair to expect them to stay late.

A further request that children are not simply dropped off to B&T without having been booked in - again, this is happening increasingly.

To book sessions: ParentMail - Accounts - B&T Club - dates 8+ days in advance are viewable/bookable/amendable

To check bookings: ParentMail - Payments - History (prob at bottom of screen) - you will then be able to click on payments made which will itemise what you have bought - from here you can see what sessions you've booked.

Cancelling/amending sessions: Sessions cancelled on the day will still be charged. If you can no longer access a day that you need to change in ParentMail, please phone the office (<2:30pm Mon, Tue, Thu, Fri; <12noon Wed)
